**Summary of BAER Team Recommendations
Cold Springs Fire - 8,393 acres**

Soil/Water Resources

- ATV seed 1 ½ miles of dozer line
- Aerial or Drill seed 3.5 miles (17.0 acres) along dozer line
- Monitor for noxious weeds
- Monitor for seeding success
- Public safety restore 1 bridge damaged by fire suppression

Wildlife Resources

- Aerially seed **2,888 acres** identified in the 8,393-acre burn perimeter.
- Monitor seeding success on 3,140 acres.
- Monitor 8,393 acres of post fire vegetation in critical big game winter range and sage grouse habitat.

Forest/Woodland

- No treatments

Cultural Resources

- Cultural resource inventory linear projects on 7.0 miles of bulldozer lines, road maintenance, and new fences.
- Law enforcement presence for cultural resource protection

Infrastructure Resources

- No treatments

Vegetation Resources

- Reconstruct 2.2 miles of protective fence
- 3.5 miles of new protective fence
- Aerial seed 1,267 acres of rangeland and monitor for success
- Noxious weed monitoring and inventory 5,000 acres
- Herbicide control of 250 acres of noxious weed
- Monitoring of burned area for natural rangeland vegetation and recovery from fire effects.
