**Summary of BAER Team Recommendations  
Wimpy Complex Fire - 2,869 acres**

**Soil/Water Resources**

- Road Maintenance 6 miles
- Aerial or Drill seed 33.6 miles (163.6 acres) along dozer line
- Rehabilitate 18.0 miles of dozer line
- Public safety restore drainage and grades to 5 miles of roads damaged by fire suppression

**Wildlife Resources**

- Monitor 2,869 acres of post fire vegetation in critical big game winter range and sage grouse habitat.

**Forest/Woodland**

- Monitor 200 acres of relic aspen/cottonwood stands for post fire regeneration to prevent unacceptable change to the ecosystem structure.

**Cultural Resources**

- Conduct field inventory on 200 acres of forested wood cutting areas that have high potential for containing significant cultural resources.
- Cultural resource inventory linear projects on 39.6 miles of bulldozer lines, road maintenance, and new fences.
- Law enforcement presence for cultural resource protection

**Infrastructure Resources**

- No treatments

**Vegetation Resources**

- Monitor and treat noxious weeds
- Monitoring of burned area for natural rangeland vegetation and recovery from fire effects.
