

SURVEY NO. 2391.

Gypsy Lode.

- 1 Discovery shaft 4x6 ft. 50 ft. deep in rock, the center of which bears from Cor. No. 1, Gypsy Lode S. 76° 22' W. 295 ft.

Value \$500.00

- 2 A shaft 4x6 ft. 75 ft. ^{deep} all in rock, the center of which bears from Cor. No. 1 S 68° W. 255 ft.

From the bottom of the shaft a drift 4x6 ft. runs S. 50° E. 25 ft.

Total value \$800.00

Other Improvements.

A hoist building 20x30 ft. the NE. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 1 Good Hope lode S. 88° 45' W. 420 ft. with hoist, engine and equipment.

The course of the long side is S. 20° W.

Instrument.

This survey was made with a Buff and Berger Mountain transit: The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by an observation of Polaris at its elongation.

The distances were measured with 100 ft., 300 ft. and 500 ft. steel tapes.

Report

The difference between length and course of lode line, Good Hope lode of this survey, and the location certificate is due to errors in the latter.

The difference in tie lines to section corners of this survey and the same as given in the location certificate is due to errors in calculating the ties of the latter.

The government section corners reported in this survey, are described as follows: Cor. of Secs. 34 and 35, T. 28 S., R. 63 E., M.D.M. is a rock 14x12x10 ins. set in a mound of stone, marked with 2 notches on E. 4 notches on W. and 6 notches on N. edge.

Cor. of Secs. 2 and 3 T. 29 S., R. 63 E., M.D.M. is a rock 20x12x12 ins. set in a mound of stone, marked with 2 notches on E. 4 notches on W. and 6 notches on S. edge.

Cor. Nos. 1-1 Sur. No. 2366 Spotted Horse and I.X.L. Lodes, is a pine post 4 ins. square, scribed 1-1-2366, is set in a mound of stone and earth and projects 2½ ft. above it.
