

SURVEY NO. 2605.

REPORT.

The S. E. Cor. of Sec. 27, T. 28 S. R. 63 E. M. D.M. reported in this survey is described as follows:

a granite rock 10 x 12 ins., 12 ins above the ground with mound of rock, chiseled two notches South and two notches East.

Each of the Corners of the Barney Riely lode, unsurveyed, mentioned above is a pine post 5 ft. long, 4 ins, square, set 2-1/2 ft. in a mound of stone and earth; one being marked N.W. Cor. Barney Riely and the other S.W. Cor. Barney Riely.

The Corners of Mondamin lode, mentioned above all pine posts 4 ins. square, projection 2-1/2 ft. above a mound of stone and earth and marked as stated above.

The intersections with the section lines were calculated from the approved field notes of the public land survey on file in the office of the Surveyor General.
