

- No. 4 The S. E. Cor. of the boarding house and office 14 X 28 ft. with celler 6 X 10 ft at the north side of the N. E. corner bears N. 46° 34' W. 208 ft. course of long side S. 80° W.
- No. 5 The S. E. Cor. of a house 10 X 12 ft bears N. 70° 38' W. 378 ft. course of long side N. 8° W. and
- No. 6 The S. E. Cor. of a house 12 X 18 bears N. 72° 43' W. 443.5 ft. course of long side S. 72° W.

I N S T R U M E N T .

This survey was made with a Gurleys Surveyor transit with solar attachment. The courses were deflected from a true meridian as determined by an observation on Polaris and checked by solar observation. The distances were measured with a 200 ft. and 50 ft. steel tapes.

NOTE.

I find the course and length of the north half of the Sec. line between Sec. 24 Tp. 28 S. Rg. 60 E. and Sec. 19 Tp. 28 S. Rg. 61 E. to be N. 1° 28' E. 2741' ft. instead of North 2640 ft. as given in official notes of survey of this line.

R E P O R T .

The 1/4 Sec. Cor on line between Sec. 24 and 19 Tp. 28 S. Rg. 60 and 61 E. Mt. Diablo B. and M. respectively is a cedar stake about 3 ins. diam. 2 ft. high in a mound of rock and earth blazed and scribed 1/4 S. on West side. I observed no marked stone.
