Improvement No. 2 on the Barney Riely lode is in course of construction from the development of the entire claim. It is intended to run cross-cuts and drifts on the several veins of the different lodes of this claim from this main working shaft, whereby one system of workings, and one plant of machinery, the entire claim can be advantageously and economically developed; an undivided one quarter interest in this improvement is credited to each lode of this claim.

INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a Buff & Berger transit No. 2; the courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by an observation on Polaris at culmination. The distances were measured with 100 ft. and 500ft. steel tapes.

NOTE:- The discrepancies existing between this survey and the amended location certificates are due to errors in the latter.

R E P O R T .

The N. E. Cor. Sec. 34, T. 28 S. R. 63 E. M. D. M. reported in this survey is a granite rock 10 x 12 ins., 12 ins. above the ground, with mound of rock, chiseled 2 notches South, and two notches East.

The Corners of Mondamin lode, unsurveyed, mentioned are pine posts, 4 ins. square, projecting 2 -1/2 ft.
