The Government Section Corner reported in this Survey as N.E.Cor. Sec. 34, Tp. 28-S., R. 63-E., M.D.M. is a Granite Rock, 10 x 12 ins. <sup>1/2 ins</sup> above the ground with mound of rock, chiseled 1 notch South and 2 notches East.

The S.E.Cor. Waterspout Lode, unsurveyed, mentioned above, is a pine post 4 ins. square, firmly set in a mound of stone and earth, marked S.E.Cor. Waterspout Lode.

The N.E.Cor. Arizona Lode, unsurveyed, mentioned above, is a pine post 4 ins. square firmly set in a mound of stone and earth, marked N.E.Cor. Arizona Lode.

Cor. No. 6, Survey No. 2366 New Years Gift Lode, identical with Cor. No. 2 Piute Lode, same survey, is a pine post 4 ft. 6 ins. long, 4 ins. square, set 2-1/2 ft. in a mound of stone and earth, scribed 6-2366.

Cor. No. 5, Survey No. 2366 New Years Gift Lode, is a pine post 4 ft. 6 ins. long, 4 ins. square, set 2-1/2 ft. in a mound of stone and earth, scribed 5-2366.
