

SURVEY NO. 2687.

REPORT.

The monument marking Cor. to Secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, T. 28 S., R. 61 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M., as found consisted of a granite stone showing about 8 x 10 ins. 14 ins. above ground, and marked with two notches on the East side and one notch on the South side.

The monument marking the 1/4 Cor. between secs. 26 and 35, T. 28 S., R. 61 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M., as found, consists of a granite stone, about 8 x 10 ins., showing 16 ins. above ground, and marked 1/4 on the North side.

The monument marking the Cor. to Secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, T. 28 S., R. 61 E., Mt. Diablo B. and M., as found consists of a granite stone about 8 x 10 ins. showing 12 ins. above ground, and set in mound of stones, and marked with one notch on the East side and one notch on the South side. The 1/4 cor. between Secs. 27 and 34 as found consists of a granite stone about 6 x 8 ins. showing 16 ins. above ground, and marked 1/4 on North side.

The 1/4 Cor. between Secs. 26 and 27 and the 1/4 Cor. between Secs. 34 and 35, after a diligent search, were not found.

The north line of Sec. 34 as traced on the ground was found to bear N.89°58'W. as against N.89°56'W. shown by the Government field notes.
