I N S T R U M E N T .

The survey of this claim was made with a Keuffel and Esser Light Mountain Transit. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by direct solar observation. The distances were measured with 500 and 100 ft. steel tapes.

NOTE:- The differences between these field notes and the location notices are due to errors in the latter.

REPORT:- The N.W. Corner Addition Lode unsurveyed, reported in this survey, identical with Cor. No. 5 Encinitas Lode, Survey No. 2656, is a pine post 4 ins. square, firmly set 2-1/2 ft. above a mound of stone and earth, marked N.E. Cor. Addition and scribed 5-2656.

The Government Sec. Corner reported in this survey as N. W. Cor. Sec. 35, Tp. 28-S., R. 63-E., M.D.M., is a granite rock 10 x 12 inches, 12 ins. above the ground with mound of rock, chiseled 1 notch South and 2 notches East.
