

## Survey No. 3722

## SURFACE

The general slope of the surface embraced in this survey is westerly. The surface consists of low rolling hills and small gulches. Vegetation is light, consisting principally of grease wood, joshua, and cactus.

## NOTE:

The difference between these field notes and location and amended location certificates is due to errors in the latter.

## REPORT.

The Government corner to secs. 34, 35, 26 and 27 Tp. 28 S. R. 63 E. M.D.M. reported in this survey is a granite rock 10 x 12 ins. 12 ins. above the ground with mound of rock.

The corners of survey No. 2624 Bonanza Lode, <sup>and Quaker Girls Lodes</sup> Survey No. 2656 Encinitas and Surprise Lodes, Survey No. 3020 Kino, Town Site Fraction, and Winner Lodes, Survey No. 3413 East End Lode, mentioned in these field notes are pine posts properly set and scribed with the numbers of their respective corners and surveys.

The east end center of Progress Lode, unsurveyed, is a pine post 4 ins. sq. projecting 4 ft. above the ground in mound of earth, marked as stated.
