

A frame house, the N. W. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 5, Techatticup Mill Site, N.68°46'E. 73.6 ft., 12x14 ft., course of long sides N.38°30'W.

A frame boarding house, the N. E. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 5, Techatticup Mill Site, S.76°36'E. 121.7 ft., 24x32 ft., with 8x18 ft. addition at N. W. Cor., making total length 40 ft. Course of long sides S.60°30'W.

An adobe store building, the N. W. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 5, Techatticup Mill Site, N.87°03'E. 185.9 ft., 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ x73 ft., with frame addition on westerly end 8 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long. Course of long sides N.57°E.

An assay office and refining building, the N. E. Cor. of which bears from Cor. No. 5, Techatticup Mill Site S.39°53'E. 268 ft., 14x45 ft., course of long sides S.81°30'W. Westernmost 21 ft. is adobe, balance frame.

A 25 stamp mill, the N. W. Cor. of the main structure of which bears from Cor. No. 5, Techatticup Mill Site, S.43°51'E. 330.3 ft., 50x62.33 ft., course of long sides N.16°W. An addition on north end, 16x45<sub>A</sub> ft., makes east side 78.33 ft. long. An addition at N. W. Cor. 13.75x31.66 ft., makes extreme with 63.75 ft. All belong to claimant herein.

#### INSTRUMENT.

This survey was made with a C. L. Berger light mining transit No. 4270. The courses were deflected from the true meridian as determined by observation on Polaris at eastern elongation. The distances were measured with 100-ft. and 500-ft. steel tapes.

#### REPORT.

The lode line of each location of this claim (except the Savage lode, a portion of which lode line is impassible) was run directly upon the ground, and the several corners established by means of offsets from the lode lines. All tie lines were run either directly upon the ground or by traverses, run upon the ground and submitted in a separate report herewith.

The S.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., Sec. 2, T. 26 S., R. 64 E., M.D.M., is a quartz rock 9x16 ins., standing 12 ins. above the ground, chiseled  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the North face.

The W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., Sec. 2, T. 26 S., R. 65 E., M.D.M., is a
