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#### Instrument.

This survey was made with a Gurley Light Mountain  
Transit. The courses were deflected from the true  
meridian as determined by solar observations .  
The distances were measured with 50 ft. and 500 ft.  
steel tapes.

a stone showing 12x7x14 ins. above the ground , no  
markings, situated on the north slope of Doherty  
Mountain .

Cor.No.2, Sur.No. 3708, Mesa lode is a pine  
post showing 4x4x39 ins. above the ground scribed  
M.2-3708,

Cor.No.4, Sur.No. 2605, Santa Fe lode is a pine  
post showing 4x4x 26 ins. above the ground scribed
