A cut, 10 ft. wide, 4 ft. face, the face of which bears S. 84°00' E., 55 ft. from Cor. No. 2, Fat Chucker 6 lode, and runs S. 60°00' W., 20 ft. to end.

A cut, 6 ft. wide, 2 ft. face, the face of which bears N. 19°21' E., 536 ft. from Cor. No. 3, Fat Chucker 5 lode, and runs SE, 20 ft. to end.

Claimant unknown.

A decline shaft, 8 x 8 ft., the center of which bears S. 4°49' W., 605 ft. from Cor. No. 4, Gingerlode 8 lode, about 40 ft. deep.

Claimant unknown.

A shaft, 8 x 8 ft., the center of which bears S. 2°01' W., 578 ft. from Cor. No. 4, Gingerlode 8 lode, 6 ft. deep.

Claimant unknown.

A cut, 8 ft. wide, 4 ft. face, the face of which bears N. 40°14' E., 560 ft. from Cor. No. 4, Gingerlode 2 lode, and runs S. 10°00' E., 20 ft. to end.

Claimant unknown.

An adit, caved, 4 x 4 ft., the portal of which bears N. 23° 23' W., 366 ft. from Cor. No. 1, Gingerlode 2 lode, and runs S. 75°00' W., about 40 ft. to breast.

Claimant unknown.

An adit, 4 x 6 ft., the portal of which bears N. 22°16' W., 344 ft. from Cor. No. 1, Gingerlode 2 lode, and runs S. 75°00' W., about 40 ft. to breast.

Claimant unknown.

A bulldozer cut equipment storage area, 40 ft. wide, the end of which bears N. 23°04' W., 527 ft. from Cor. No. 1, Gingerlode 2 lode and runs NW, 160 ft. to end.

The cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27, T. 28 S., R. 61 E., M.D.M., is monumented with a stone 8 x 8 ins., projecting 18 ins. above ground, mkd. with 2 notches on the N. side, and 2 notches on the E. side, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. diam., 1 ft. high.
