Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 22, with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 22, with brass cap mkd.
