A point 74 lks. E. of the original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., which is a quartz stone, 16x11x8 ins., set in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. side.

I obliterate all evidence of this corner.

A point 67 lks. E. of the original cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22.; a granite stone, 18x12x6 ins., set in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, marked with 3 notches on S. and 3 notches on E. side.


