mound of stone 3 ft. base and 2 ft. high, south of cor.

40.45 The orig. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a granite stone, 18x10x6 ins. above ground, set in a mound of stone 3 ft. base and 1 ft. high, and marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. side; as this cor. now refers to sec. 15, only.
At point for cor.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. sec. 15, only, with brass cap mkd.

mound of stone 3 ft. base and 2 ft. high, North of cor.

Thence, N.87°08'W., on true line bet. secs. 15 and 22. (W $\frac{1}{2}$)

Descend 80 ft. over a gentle SW.slope, thru undergrowth.

40.31 The cor. of secs. 15,16,21 and 22, which is a granite stone, 20x11x8 ins. above ground, set in a mound of stone 3 ft. base and 1 ft. high and marked with 3 notches on S. and E. sides.

At point for cor.

Set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with the original stone cor. set alongside, for cor. of secs. 15,16,21 and 22, with brass cap marked

40.00 Find no trace of orig. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

60.71 Record dist.; find no trace of clos. cor. secs. 21 and 22.

82.65 Intersect the Von Schmidt California-Nevada line at a point from which the 564 mile cor. (hereinafter described) bears N.45°39'W., 53.43 chs. dist.

Return to the cor. of secs. 15,16,21 and 22.

Thence, south on true line bet. frac. secs. 21 and 22.

Descend 53 ft. over a gentle SW. slope, thru undergrowth.

23.14 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.
