 33.00 Top of Spur, bears N. E. & S. W. and descend.
 40.00 Set a Basalt stone $1\frac{1}{4} \times 12 \times 8$ ins. 9
 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N,
 face and raised a mound of stone.

Pits impracticable.

- 80.00 Set a Basalt stone $20 \times 16 \times 8$ ins. 15 ins. in the
 ground, for Cor. to Tps. 26 and 27 S; R's 62 and
 63 E, marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a
 mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
