North on a true line between sections 31-36

Va. 15° East.

Ascend.

- 26.00 Top of Ridge, bears N. N. and S. E., and descend.
- 36.00 Cross Gulch, 20 fms. wide, Course N. E.
- 40.00 Set a Granite stone 16 x 12 x 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on face and raised a mound of stone.
- Pits impracticable.
- 43.00 Cross Gulch, 20 fms. wide, Course East.
- 54.50 Cross Gulch, 15 fms. wide, Course S. E., and ascend.
- 70.00 Top of Ridge, bears E & W, and descend.
- 80.00 Set a Granite stone 16 x 14 x 10 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25-30-31-36 marked with / notch on S. and 5 notches on E. edges and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
