

N. 26 S., R. 65 E., Mt. D. M.

Chains.

Mark on a true line between sections 1-6
Va. 15° East.

Ascend.

21.00 Top of Ridge, bears E. & N. and descend.

29.25 Cross Road, bears E. & N.

30.20 Cross Wash, 200 yds. wide, Course N, and ascend.

34.00 Top of Ridge, bears E. & N. and descend.

40.00 Set a Granite stone 12 x 10 x 6 ins. 1/2 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/2 on N, face and raised a mound of stone.

Pits impracticable.

62.00 Cross Gulch, 100 yds. wide, Course East,

79.00 Cross Wash, 500 yds. wide, Course East,

80.00 Set a Granite stone 24 x 18 x 12 ins. 1/8 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 25 and 26 S R's 65 and 66 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

Land mountainous.

Soil 3rd rate Vegetation, *Bunchgrass*.
I carefully examined the adjustments of my solar compass to-day, particularly the latitude and reversing apparatus, and found them correct. Sept. 13, 1882.
