Chains.

Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this Tps. I made a change of 6 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by subtracting same from the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing.

From the Cor. to Tps. 30<sup>th</sup> & 31<sup>st</sup> D. Rs. 63 & 64 E.,

I run,

North between sections 31<sup>st</sup> & 36,  
Variation 1500' East.

Over rolling land.

40.00 Set a Gascoet stone 21 x 16 x 12 ins., 16 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 on W. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N and S. of stone 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base. alongside.

80.00 Set a Gascoet stone 17 x 14 x 14 ins. 11 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25, 30, 31<sup>st</sup> & 36, marked with 7 notch on S. and 5 notches on W edges, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each Sec., 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high 4 1/2 ft. base. alongside.
