## Chains.

South on a true line between sections 15<sup>and</sup> 16.

Va. 1500' East.

Ascend.

- 20.00 Top of Spur, bears E. and descend.
- 40.00 Set a granite stone 15 x 10 x 8 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N. and S. of stone  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base. alongside.
- 48.00 Cross Wash, 100 lks. wide, Course S.E. and ascend.
- 64.00 Intersect Boundary line between Nevada. and California. at a point which bears 36.75 chs. S. 45 E. from the ~~66<sup>th</sup>~~<sup>604<sup>th</sup></sup> Mile post, which is a part with Charred block, marked C. H., with pits and a mound of earth and stone. The post marked C. ~~66<sup>th</sup>~~<sup>604<sup>th</sup></sup> miles on N. W.; Nev. on N. E.; Cal. on S. W. and 1878 on S. E. sides and
- Set a granite stone 12 x 10 x 7 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 15 and 16 marked C. C. with 3 notch  $\infty$  on E. and 3 notch  $\infty$  on W. edges and raised a mound of stone. alongside.
