Chains

Intersect mean high-water line on right bank of Colorado River; impracticable to set meander cor. on account of insecure silt bottom land.

SUBDIVISION OF FRAC. T. 33 S., R. 66 E.

From monument No. 141 on the California-Nevada state boundary, hereinbefore described.

S. 45° 33' E., along California-Nevada state boundary.



Closing cor. of frac. Tps. 33 S., Rs. 65 and 66 E., hereinbefore described.

At southing of 80.00 chs. from the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, and 30, Tps. 33 S., Rs. 65 and 66 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of frac. secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap mkd.



raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, E. of cor.

From this point, the cor. at the intersection of the California-Nevada state boundary with the bdy. of the Fort Mohave Indian Reservation, hereinbefore described bears S. 45° 33' E., 1.86 chs. dist.


Thence

East, bet. frac. secs. 30 and 31.

Gradual ascent over rolling bench land through scattering creosote brush, chaparral, cactus and weeds.

Intersect bdy. of Fort Mohave Indian Reservation; set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the closing cor. of frac. secs. 30 and 31, with brass cap mkd.



raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 3 ft. high, W. of cor.

From this point the cor. at the intersection of the California-Nevada state boundary with the boundary of the Fort Mohave Indian Reservation, bears S. 33° 09' W., 1.55 chs. dist.

From same point the 24 mile monument, bears S. 33° 09' W., 4.54 chs. dist., an iron post, 2 ins. diam., above ground, firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official record.
