

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF T. 27 S., R. 63 E.

Chains

A point East of the cor. of Ts. 26 and 27 S., Rs. 62 and 63 E.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with a granite rock, 15x10x6 ins., mkd. X deposited at the base, for cor. of Ts. 26 and 27 S., Rs. 63 and 64 E., with brass cap mkd.

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BDY. OF T. 27 S., R. 62 E.,

Superseding the survey executed by Deputy Surveyor W. H. Myrick in May, 1883, under Contract No. 145 dated July 11, 1882.

Diligent search was made for all original corners along this boundary. All corners that were found are described and the connection is entered in the record, after which all trace of the original corner was destroyed.

From the cor. of Ts. 27 and 28 S., Rs. 62 and 63 E., which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of T. 28 S., R. 63 E.

North, on a true line along the E. bdy. of Sec. 36.

Over rolling hilly land through medium dense undergrowth. Asc. along a broken E. slope.

12.20 Flat-topped divide, bears E. and W.; desc. along an E. slope.

22.60 Slope changes to NE.; desc. 100 ft.

32.20 Drain, course N. 60° E., 3 chs. to junction.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with a basalt rock, 11x7x6 ins., mkd. X deposited at the base, and in a large mound of stones for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36 only with brass cap mkd.

57.40 Minor spur, slopes NW.; desc. 30 ft. over NE. slope.

60.50 Small draw, drains N. 60° W.; asc. SW. slope.66.80 Spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 60 ft. over NE. slope.
