

INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 27 S., R. 63 E.

Chains

Land, rolling.
Soil, gravelly, 3d rate.
No timber.
Undergrowth, creosote, black brush, cacti, bunch grass.
Grazing, good.

From the cor. of secs. 34 and 35 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., an iron post, 2 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of T. 28 S., R. 63 E.

N.0°01'W., bet. secs. 34 and 35.

Over rolling land through medium dense undergrowth.

15.10 Wash, 100 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course N.15°E.

21.80 Recross same wash, course N.35°W.

35.90 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course N.30°W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound
of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35, with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound
of stone, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 3 ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, rolling.
Soil, sandy to gravelly, 3d rate.
No timber.
Undergrowth, creosote, black brush, cacti, grasses.
Grazing, good.

East, on a random line bet. secs. 26 and 35,

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

80.00 Intersect N. and S. line 7 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36.

Thence

S.89°57'W. on a true line bet. secs. 26 and 35.

Over gentle rolling land through medium dense undergrowth.

35.20 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course N.15°W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with a basalt stone, 6x5x4 ins., mkd. X deposited at the base, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
