

## INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISION OF T. 27 S., R. 63 E.

Chains 37.00	Wash, 20 lks. wide, course NE.
41.22	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.  $\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \\   \\ S5 \quad   \quad S4 \\   \\ 1940 \end{array}$ <p style="text-align: right;">raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, <math>1\frac{1}{2}</math> ft. high, W. of cor.</p>
44.20	Wash, 10 lks. wide, course NE.
68.40	Wash, 15 lks. wide, course NE.
81.22	The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9.  Land, rolling. Soil, gravelly, 3d rate. No timber. Undergrowth, creosote, black brush, cacti, rabbit brush, grasses. Grazing, good.
	From the cor. of secs. 31 and 32 on the S. bdy. of Tp., which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of T. 28 S., R. 63 E.  N. $0^{\circ}03'$ W. bet. secs. 31 and 32.  Desc. 180 ft. over rocky NW. slope, through medium dense undergrowth.
11.00	Draw, drains W.; asc. 80 ft. over rocky SW. slope.
16.10	Spur, slopes W.; desc. 140 ft. over NW. slope.
26.00	Slope becomes more gradual; desc. 140 ft. to large wash.
39.03	A point 40 chs. S. $0^{\circ}03'$ E. of the Sectional Correction Line.  Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.  $\begin{array}{c} \frac{1}{4} \\   \\ S31 \quad   \quad S32 \\   \\ 1940 \end{array}$ <p style="text-align: right;">raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p>
44.20	Large wash, 250 lks. wide, course N. $80^{\circ}$ E.; asc. 100 ft. over SE. slope.
53.00	Slope changes to rocky, abrupt S. slope; asc. 250 ft.
61.60	Crest of ascent slopes SW. from peak 2 chs. E.; desc. 230 ft. over N. slope.
70.70	Drain, near head, course N. $10^{\circ}$ W., along W. slope.
79.03	Intersect the Sectional Correction line at a point West, 79.96 chs. dist. from the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33.  Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., over a cross X cut on solid rock, and in a large mound of stone to top of post, for cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, with brass cap mkd.
