The original cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, which is a basalt stone, 18x8x5 ins., mkd. 5 notches on one side and 1 notch on the opposite side, loosely set. This cor. is now changed to refer to secs. 6 and 7 only.

At cor. point,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with the original cor. stone deposited at the base, for cor. of secs. 6 and 7 only, with brass cap mkd.

N. 0° 55' W., along the W. bdy. of sec. 6.

Over rolling desert land, through scattering joshua trees and undergrowth.

7.00 Wash, 50 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course S. 70° E.; asc. 70 ft. over S. slope.

19.00 Spur, projects W.; desc. 30 ft. over N. slope.

32.00 Draw, drains S. 60° W.; asc. over a gentle SW. slope.

33.37 At 40.00 chs. northing from cor. of secs. 1 and 12,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 1 only, with brass cap mkd.
