

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE NORTH BDY. OF T. 28 S., R. 63 E.

Chains	
10.00	Draw, drains N. 20° W. from SE. Line follows along N. slope.
16.20	Draw, drains N. 20° E.; asc. 190 ft. over E. slope.
25.10	Spur, slopes N.; desc. 110 ft. over W. slope.
35.10	Draw, near head, drains N. 20° E.; asc. 50 ft. over E. slope.
37.83	At 40.00 chs. westing from the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., on solid rock, with a limestone, 8x6x5 ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31 only, with brass cap mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 <hr/> 1940
39.47	Proportionate distance; no evidence of original cor. could be found. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with a basalt stone, 10x8x3 ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6 only, with brass cap mkd. <hr/> $\frac{1}{4}$ S 6 1940 Asc. 70 ft. over E. slope.
44.20	Ridge, bears S. 10° E. and NW.; asc. 20 ft. along rolling southerly slope.
55.30	Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 100 ft. over W. slope.
76.50	Wash, near head, 10 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course S.; asc. 20 ft. over E. slope.
79.23	The cor. of Ts. 27 and 28 S., Rs. 62 and 63 E. Land, rolling hills. Soil, rocky and gravelly; 2nd and 3rd rate. Timber, joshua trees. Undergrowth, creosote brush, yucca and cactus, along with a medium growth of grass and weeds. Grazing, fair.

From the standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of T. 28 S., R. 63 E.,	
N. 1° 13' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36,	
Over gently rolling land, through scattering joshua trees and medium dense undergrowth; asc. over gentle S. slope.	
24.20	Unimproved road, bears S. 85° E. and N. 85° W., $3\frac{1}{2}$ chs. to junction with road bearing NE. and SW.
27.70	Unimproved road, bears N. 50° E. to Colorado River and S. 50° W.
39.54	Proportionate distance; no evidence of original cor. could be found.
