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General Description

This fractional township, consisting only of frac. sec. 5, is located between the Ft. Mohave Indian Reservation and the Nevada-California state boundary, in the tri-state corner area of Nevada, California and Arizona.

The area is a part of the former flood plain of the Colorado River. A dense growth of willow, mesquite and cottonwood timber and young timber and arrowweed covers the entire area.

The access road from the river levees to the rock quarry, about 4 miles distant northwest, runs through the area.

There is no use or occupancy of the land.
