Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
U.S. Deputy Surveyor T. A. Magee  
in 1883

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a conglomerate stone, 14X10X10 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone and plainly mkd. with 3 notches on E. and W. edges, with an iron pin, 1 in. diam., firmly set showing 3 ins. above ground, with brass cap, 2 ins. diam., mkd. T3OSR64E 3 4 33 34 1986 RLS 2002, as recorded in Clark County, Record of Survey No. 623.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the stainless steel post and reset the RLS iron pin inside the stainless steel post.

From this corner, an unmarked limestone, 8X8X6 ins., loosely set in a mound of earth, bears S. 32° 10' E., 0.87 chs. dist., with a wooden post, 4 ins. square, 4 ft. long, lying loosely alongside. This point is recorded in Clark County, Record of Survey No. 557, no original evidence found, therefore was not utilized in the course of this survey.

From this same corner, U.S.C. & G.S. triangulation station "IBEX," a bronze disk, 3 ins. diam., seated in concrete monumented, 12 ins. square, set flush with ground, bears N. 20° 21' W., (mean bearing) 479.14 chs. dist.

N. 89° 41' W., bet. secs. 4 and 33.

Over gently rolling W. slope, covered with creosote, greasewood and scattered cacti.
