80.57	The cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, on the W. bdy. of the Tp.

	Over gently rolling land, covered with creosote, greasewood and scattered cacti.
5.30	Piute Wash, 100 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, drains SW.
37.10	Trail road, bears E. and W.
40.20	Point for the center ¼ sec. cor of sec. 31, at intersection with the E-W center line.
	Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
