


TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, CALIFORNIA AND NEVADA
RETRACEMENT AND DEPENDENT RESURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the retracement of portions of the 1872 survey of the Eastern Boundary of California, between mile corners 320+25 and 330+26, and the 1893-1899 U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey California-Nevada Oblique Boundary Line between Point Numbers 58, 59 and 59 1/2, and the dependent resurvey of a portion of the Mount Diablo Base Line through Range 32 East and a portion of the subdivisional lines of Township 1 North, Range 32 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, California and Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved August 12, 1879.

Survey executed by Brock R. Clifford, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning September 9, 1994 and completed September 26, 1995, pursuant to Special Instructions dated September 2, 1994, for Group No. 1213, California and Special Instructions dated September 2, 1994, for Group No. 749, Nevada.
