


TOWNSHIP 3 NORTH, RANGE 69 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

A dependent resurvey of a portion of the east boundary was executed concurrently under T. 3 N., R. 70 E., of this Group.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the south boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 3 N., R. 69 E., designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

Sec. 18 Lottings and areas, except as shown hereon, are as shown on the plat approved February 28, 1903, and accepted April 8, 1903.


