


TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 67 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA RETRACEMENT



History of earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the retracement of the survey made by Monroe and Bateman in 1872-73 of the north three miles of the west boundary and the west three miles of the north boundary of T. 4 N., R. 67 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada. A retracement of the west three miles of the south boundary of T. 5 N., R. 67 E., as resurveyed by T. K. Stewart in 1902, was made concurrently and is recorded in the field notes of that township. These retracements indicate the existence of a tract (or hiatus) of unsurveyed public land between these boundaries.

These retracements also indicate the existence of a wedge-shaped tract (or hiatus) of unsurveyed public land between the east boundary of secs. 4, 9, 16, and 21 as surveyed in 1873 by Monroe and Bateman and as resurveyed by Carl S. Swanholm in 1923.

Survey executed by Philip L. Inch, April 27 to May 19, 1938, under special instructions dated February 25, 1937 for Group 199, Nevada.
