



ENLARGED DIAGRAM OF SE. 1/4 OF SEC. 4




History of the earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 11 N., R. 21 E., designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

Lottings and areas, except as shown hereon, are as shown on the plat approved October 27, 1881.

Survey executed by Robert A. Pratt, Cadastral Surveyor, April 19, 1982 to January 5, 1983, under Special Instructions dated March 29, 1982, for Group 599, Nevada.




NOTE:

The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10, the E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, and the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4 are to be reestablished:

Therefore, the N 1/2 mile between secs. 9 and 10, the mile between secs. 3 and 4, the E 1/2 mile between secs. 4 and 9, and the lottings in sec. 4 are canceled.
