


TOWNSHIP 12 NORTH, RANGE 19 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA & CALIFORNIA



DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND EXTENSION SURVEY



This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of a portion of the boundaries and subdivisional lines designed to restore corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of a portion of the west boundary and subdivisional lines.

The lottings and areas are as shown on plats approved June 28, 1862 and July 8, 1875, except as new areas are shown hereon.

Survey executed by Carl S. Swanholm, Roger F. Wilson and G. Marvin Litz, Cadastral Engineers and Wilson McConkie, Public Land Surveyor, September 7, 1939 to September 12, 1950, under Special Instructions for Group 281 California, and Group 245 Nevada, dated April 25, 1932 and December 28, 1937.
