

 CORRECTIVE DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND CORRECTIVE SURVEY





History of the earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a corrective dependent resurvey of a portion of the east boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence and the corrective survey of the northeast 1/4 of section 24, T. 12 N., R. 21 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Lottings and areas, except as shown hereon, are as shown on the plat approved October 27, 1881 and the plats accepted May 5, 1976 and January 20, 1978.
