


Supplemental Plat

Dependent Resurvey Secs. 23, 26, 36, Part of Sec. 35

Survey of Indian Allotments Nos. 106, 108, 493 & M E Church



This plat of the resurvey of Secs. 23, 26, 35 and 36, T. 13 N., R. 28 E. delineates a retracement and re-establishment of the lines of the original survey as shown upon the plat approved Oct. 27, 1905, in their true original position according to the best available evidence of the original corners; all differences between the measurements shown on the original plat and those derived in the retracements have been distributed proportionally between accepted corners in accordance with surveying rules. The survey of Indian allotments by partial subdivision of secs. 23, 26, 35 and 36, and monumentation of the resulting boundaries is shown. The table gives the allotment numbers and their original descriptions.
