

This plat, in 6 sheets, represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the south boundary, a portion of the east boundary, a portion of the subdivisional lines and the subdivision of a portion of sections 26 and 36, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of sections 21, 22, 26, 27 and 36 of T. 13 N., R. 28 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.


