


TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH, RANGE 63 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA


DEPENDENT RESURVEY, AND SUBDIVISION OF SECTIONS 25 AND 36



History of earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the south and east boundaries and a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 17 N., R. 63 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence and the survey of the subdivision of secs. 25 and 36. Areas are as shown on plats approved June 15, 1872 and Sept. 28, 1878.

Survey executed by Horace G. Parker November 28, 1955 to January 11, 1956 under special instructions dated Oct. 17, 1955 for Group 361, Nevada.
