


# TOWNSHIP 17 NORTH, RANGE 64 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA



## DEPENDENT RESURVEY



History of earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 17 N., R. 64 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence. Lottings and areas are as shown on plats approved June 15, 1872 and May 4, 1875, and plat accepted November 7, 1955.

Survey executed by Horace G. Parker, December 8, 1955 to January 11, 1956, under special instructions dated Oct. 17, 1955 for Group 361, Nevada.
