


TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 65 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY




Portions of the north and south boundaries and subdivisional lines were surveyed by E. B. Monroe and A. G. Bateman in 1872.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of portions of the north and south boundaries and subdivisional lines of T. 18 N., R. 65 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence; except as shown hereon, lottings and areas are as shown on plat approved June 15, 1872.
