


TOWNSHIP N°32 NORTH RANGE N°37 EAST

Ridgway, U.S. Cadastral Engineer, June 19 to 20, 1929, inclusive, under Special Instructions dated March 14, 1928, for Group No. 148, authorized by the Commissioner's letter "E", dated Aug. 27, 1927.

Boundaries of Sec. 17, surveyed by T.A. Haigh, U.S. Surveyor and A.T. Harris, U.S. Transitman in 1913, as shown upon plat approved April 10, 1915.
