



TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 66 EAST OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA.  
DEPENDENT RESURVEY



Area Resurveyed 25.37 Acres

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of the fractional township designed to restore the lines and corners thereof in their original positions according to the best available evidence.

The original surveys were executed by Carl S. Swanholm, Cadastral Engineer, in 1932, under Group 157, as shown upon the plat accepted February 3, 1940. Subsequent to that work, surveys within fractional T. 11 N., R. 22 E., S.B.M., California, were completed in 1933, as shown upon the plat accepted May 9, 1935, which surveys established closing corners upon the California-Nevada state boundary.

In the late 1950's the Colorado River was re-channelized and confined within this vicinity. The position of the Arizona-Nevada state boundary, in the river's present channel, is shown in accordance with P.L. 87-50, 87th Congress, June 16, 1961.

These surveys were executed by Eldon W. Sibley, Cadastral Surveyor, on December 18-19, 1961, pursuant to special instructions dated October 6, 1961, for Group 395, Nevada.
