


TOWNSHIP N° 44 NORTH RANGE N° 38 EAST

The above supplemental plat of Secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33, Township No. 44 North, Range 38 East, of the Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, based upon the plat approved May 21, 1913, and the resurvey of the south boundary of same township by Walter H. Good, U.S. Surveyor, in 1924, and an investigation by Carl S. Swanholm, U.S. Cadastral Engineer, in 1926, showing additional lotting and relotting on account of the segregation of H.E.S. No. 90 and mineral surveys Nos. 4242, 37, 38 and 39, (the location of the three latter surveys having been corrected in accordance with the findings of Carl S. Swanholm in the above mentioned investigation), prepared in accordance with instructions contained in Commissioner's letter "E" dated May 3, 1927, is hereby approved.
