


# TOWNSHIP 45 NORTH, RANGE 62 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

A dependent resurvey of a portion of the west boundary with ties to corners on the Ninth Standard Parallel North, and a dependent resurvey of the Ninth Standard Parallel North, through a portion of R. 62 E., was executed concurrently under T. 45 N., R. 61 E., and T. 46 N., R. 62 E., respectively of this Group.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 45 N., R. 62 E., designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence.

Lottings and areas, except as shown hereon, are as shown on the plat approved February 21, 1900.


