


# TOWNSHIP 48 NORTH, RANGE 38 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

The Nevada-Oregon State boundary through R. 38 E. was surveyed by D. A. Major in 1872; the south and east boundaries and subdivisional lines were surveyed by D. Van Lene in 1878.


This plat represents the retracement and reestablishment of the Nevada-Oregon State boundary and the dependent resurvey of the east boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 48 N., R. 38 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence; except as shown hereon, lottings and areas are as shown on plat approved April 4, 1891.

Survey executed by Woodrow H. Sylvester and Chester C. Ellicott, October 18 to 29, 1957, under special instructions dated September 8, 1954 for Group 359, Nevada.
