## **BLM ELKO LAND SALE RESULTS**

Two of five parcels of public land in Elko County, Nevada, offered for sale under the provisions of the Federal Land Transaction Facilitation Act of 2000 were sold at auction at the BLM Elko Field Office on September 15, 2004.

A 40-acre parcel was offered for \$4,600 and sold for \$16,500, and a 254.4-acre parcel was offered for \$59,000 and sold for \$62,000. The three unsold parcels totaling 352 acres will be offered at a sale scheduled in Las Vegas in February 2005.

“There has been a lot of interest in the amount of public lands in northeastern Nevada versus private lands,” said BLM Elko Field Manager Helen Hankins. “We made a commitment to offer some public lands parcels for sale in Elko County and we did.”
