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## CORRECTION NOTICE

The following changes affect the September 14, 2004, Nevada State Office, Competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sale notice:

**Lease Notice OG-047-5** has been included to the following parcels

This lease contains lands which are located within the Sunshine Locality National Register District and may contain fragile prehistoric and/or paleo-environmental resources.

### Description of Lands

<b>PARCEL NV-04-09-0079</b>	<b>T. 20 N., R. 58 E., MDM, Nevada sec. 19, lots 3,4, E2SW, SE; sec. 20, S2; sec. 29,all; sec. 30, lots 1-4, E2, E2W2.</b>
<b>PARCEL NV-04-09-0080</b>	<b>T. 20 N., R. 58 E., MDM, Nevada sec. 21, S2; sec. 28, all.</b>
<b>PARCEL NV-04-09-0081</b>	<b>T. 20 N., R. 58 E., MDM, Nevada sec. 27, all.</b>
<b>PARCEL NV-04-09-0082</b>	<b>ALL LANDS</b>

- a. Prior to any surface disturbing operations for exploration or development within the above described lands, a Class III cultural resources inventory must be completed and approved by the Authorizing Officer.**
- b. A Section 106 consultation under the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) with the State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) for a Determination of Effect must be completed prior to actual operations. The consultation process may involve review by the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP) Western Office of**

**Project Review (WOPR) and development of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the SHPO and ACHP . These procedures may delay the operation up to 120 additional days above 60-day timing limitations allowed under section 6 of the lease instrument. Treatment Plans and data recovery may also be required at the expense of the operator prior to approval of operations. Data recovery may also result in additional delays which may exceed 120 days in addition to the Section 106 consultation process.**

- c. During actual surface disturbing operations an archaeologist shall be required to be present to monitor activities.**
- d. Upon completion of operations, special reclamation measures for the surface may be required as set forth under Memorandum of Agreement with the SHPO and the ACHP.**
