Bureau of Land Management Nevada Internet Sites Now On Line

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) in Nevada announces that its web site is now back on line at [www.nv.blm.gov](http://www.nv.blm.gov). Internet users can access the websites for all BLM Nevada offices through this URL.

The BLM's Washington Office and Wild Horse and Burro information sites were reconnected earlier. The Bureau initially disconnected all web sites so that site security could be improved. Sites have been reconnected as the security for each was upgraded.

“The BLM recognizes the impact of this disconnection to its customers,” said BLM Nevada State Director Ron Wenker. “We thank them for their patience and understanding during this period.”

“The last few months have posed challenges to providing timely information to the citizens we serve, and making sure that all who are interested receive timely information about the agency's actions has and continues to be a priority for the entire agency.”

The BLM is now concentrating on reconnecting sites that provide interactive non-Indian Trust data and services. Unfortunately, sites of this kind are more complex and time consuming to reconnect. Additional announcements will be made as other sites, such as the land status data base, are reconnected.
