Red Rock Canyon Hours Change

Las Vegas -- Red Rock National Conservation Area has switched to winter hours of operation.

The 13-mile scenic drive will open at 6 a.m. and entrance gates will close at 5 p.m. The visitor center opens at 8 a.m. and close at 4:30 p.m.

On Thursday, November 6, the visitor center will be closed for routine maintenance.

Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area encompasses 197,000 acres within the Mojave Desert and provides a 13 mile scenic drive and more than 30 miles of hiking trails. The Red Rock Canyon Visitor Center offers information about recreation opportunities, wildlife, wild horses and burros, vegetation, geology and cultural resources. In 1990, special legislation supported by the Nevada congressional delegation changed the status of the Red Rock Recreation Lands to a National Conservation Area.
